2. What is your gender?

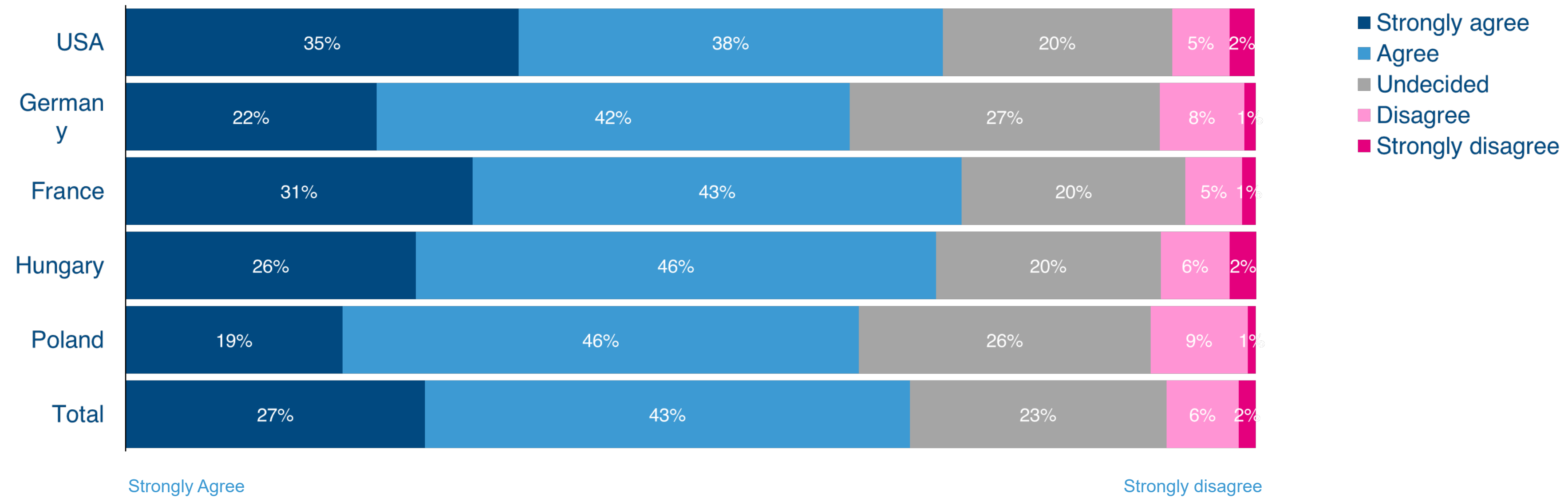

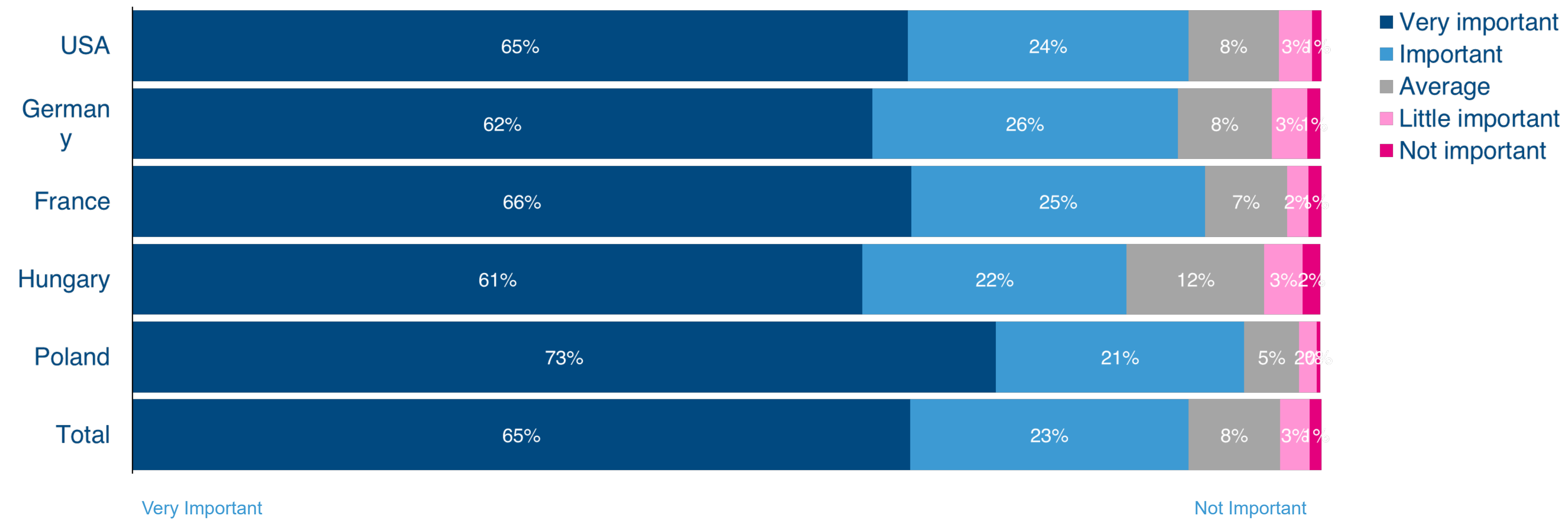

Right to own property.



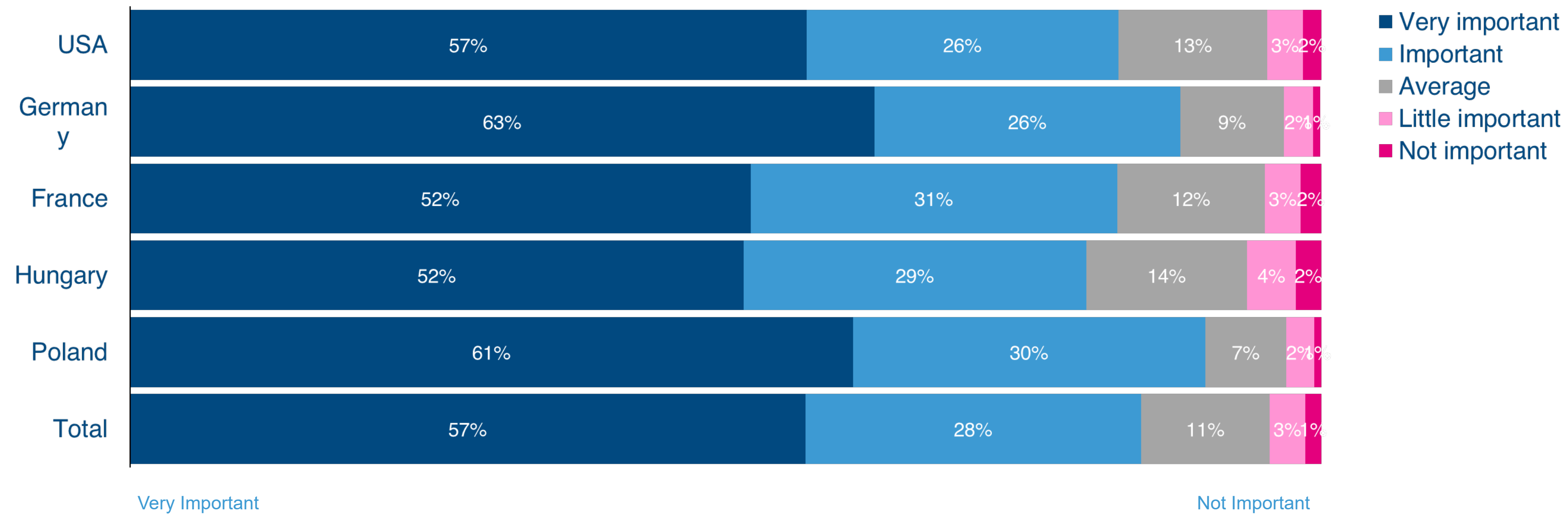
12. How important or unimportant do you rate the following human rights?

Right to privacy.



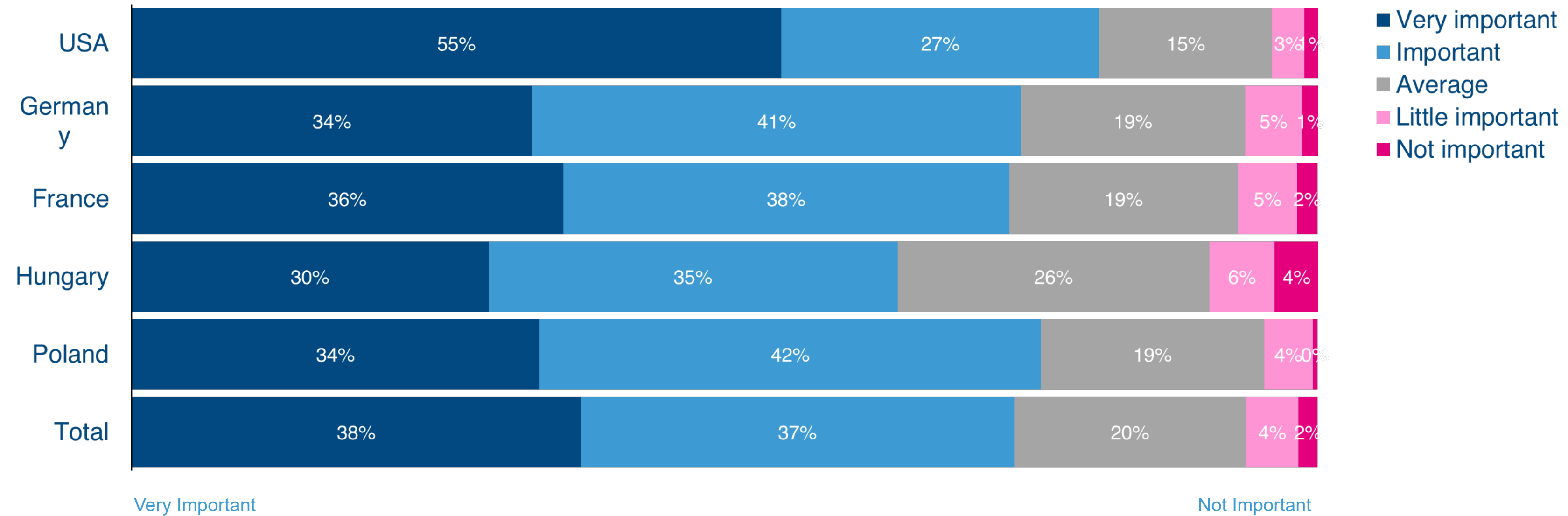
13. How important or unimportant do you rate the following human rights?

Freedom of opinion.



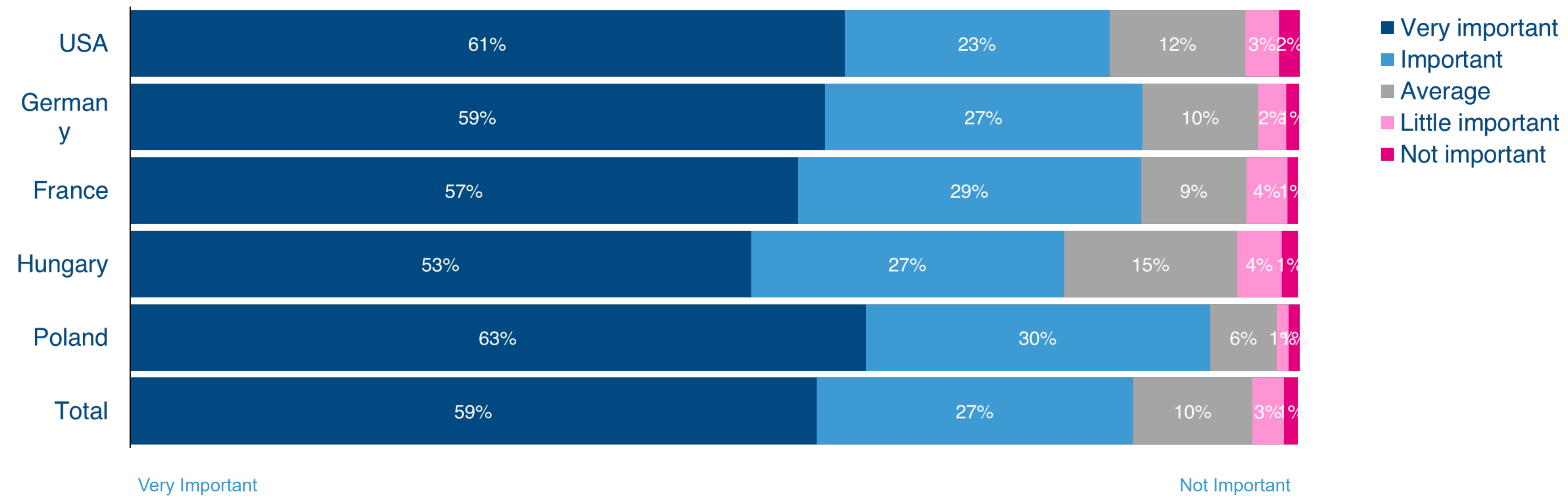
14. How important or unimportant do you rate the following human rights?

Freedom of assembly.



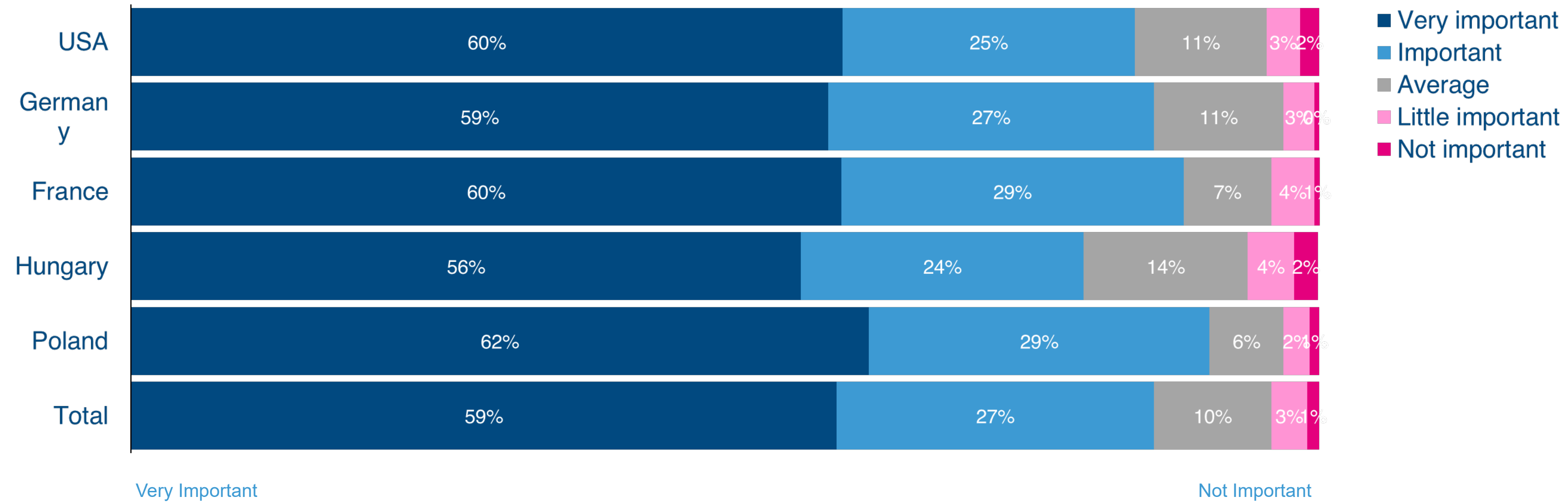
15. How important or unimportant do you rate the following human rights?

Right to free and fair elections.



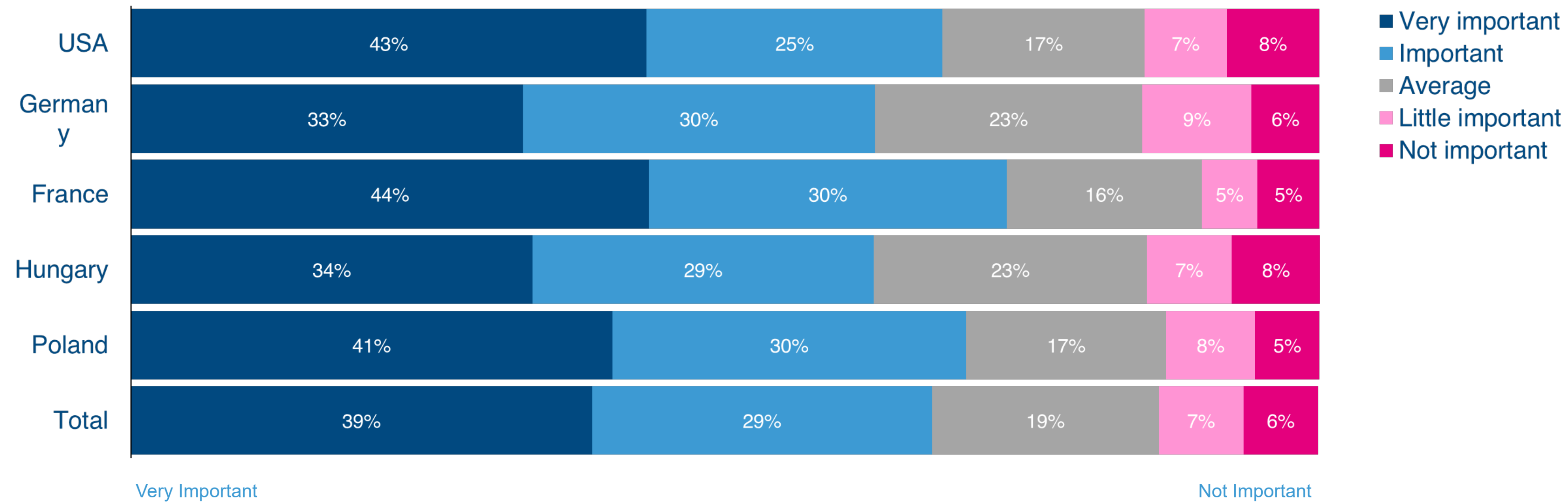

Right to equality before the law.



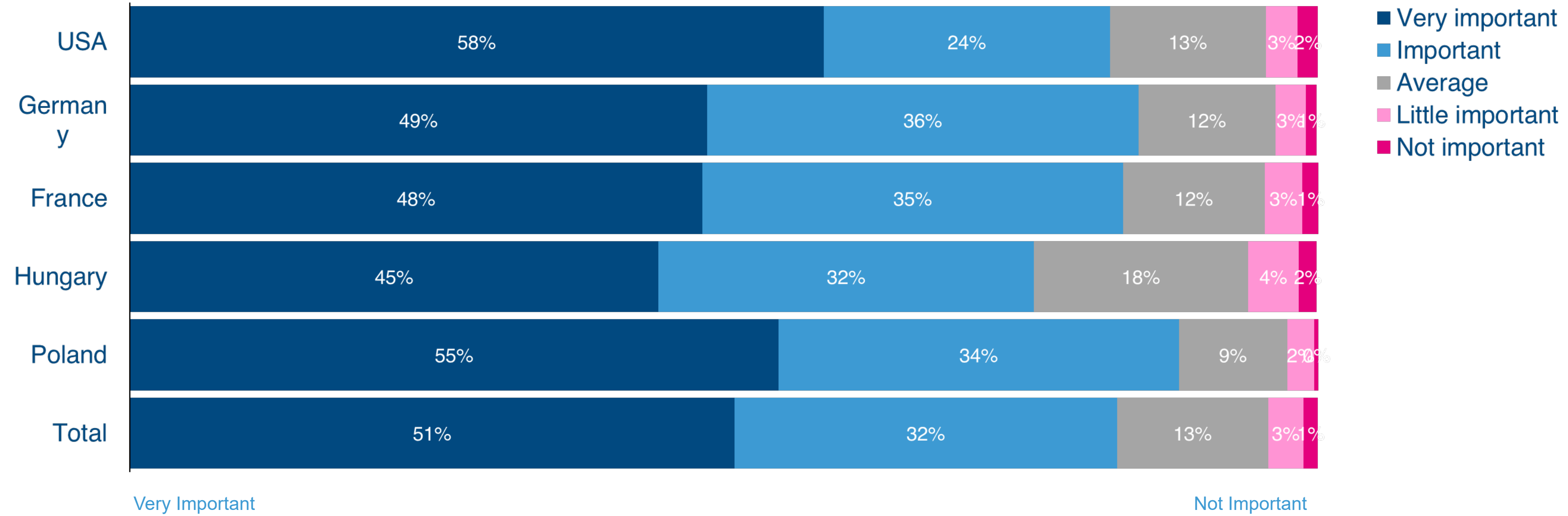

Right to sexual orientation and gender identity.



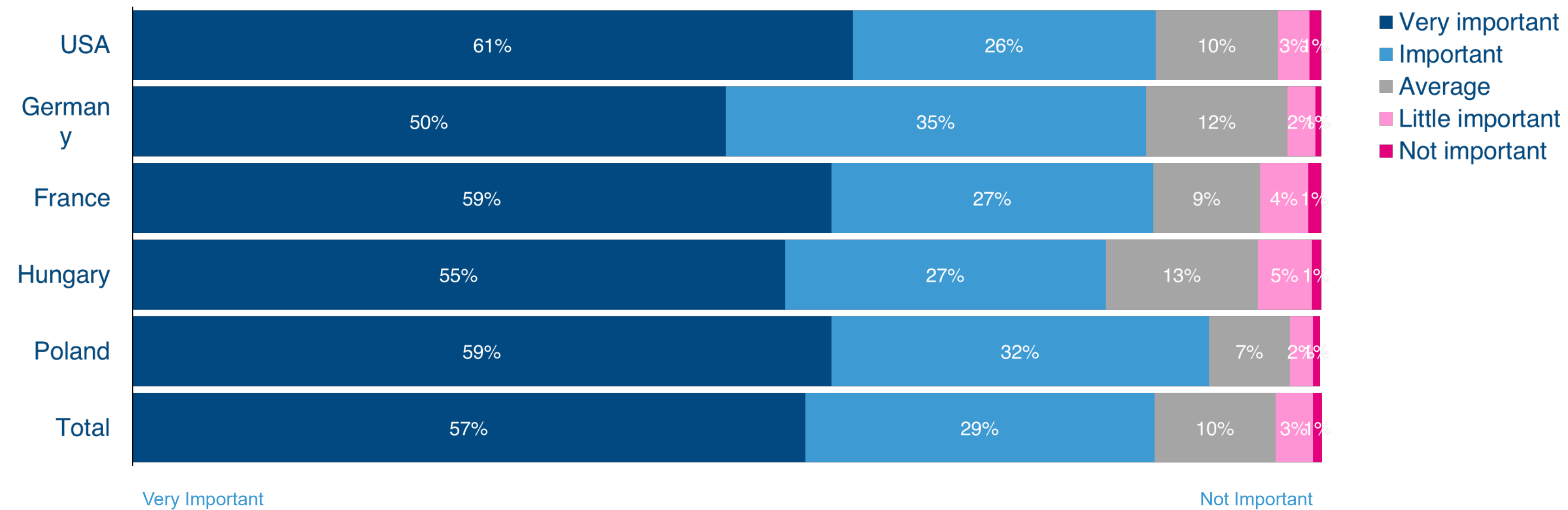

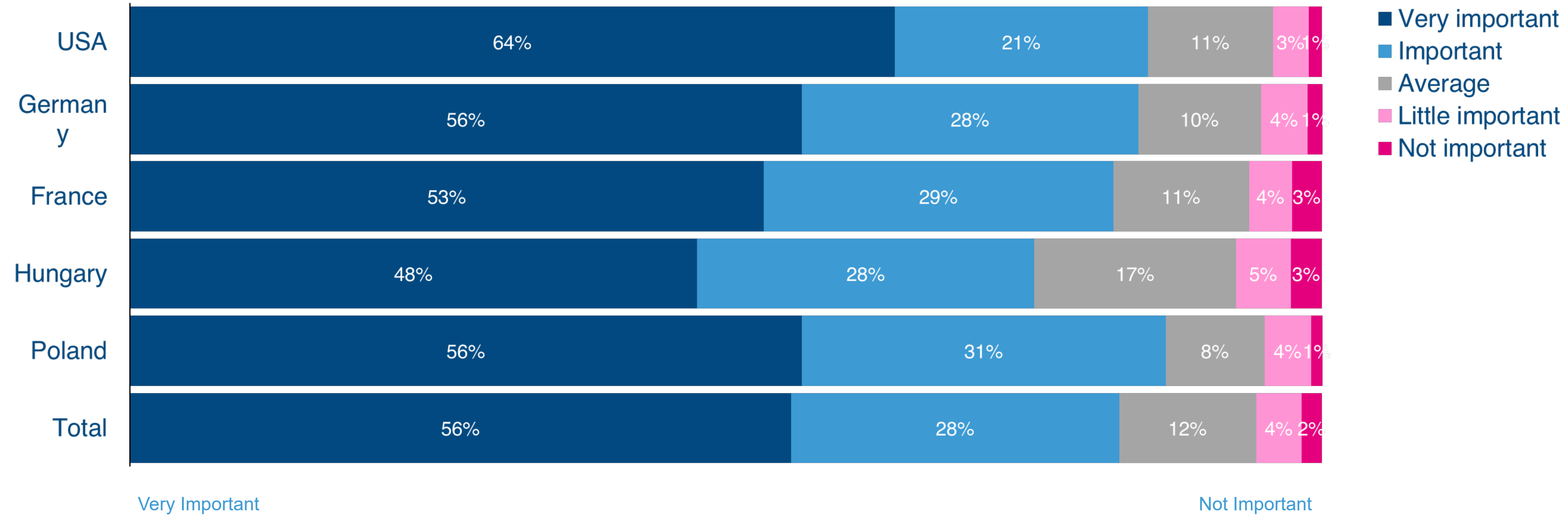

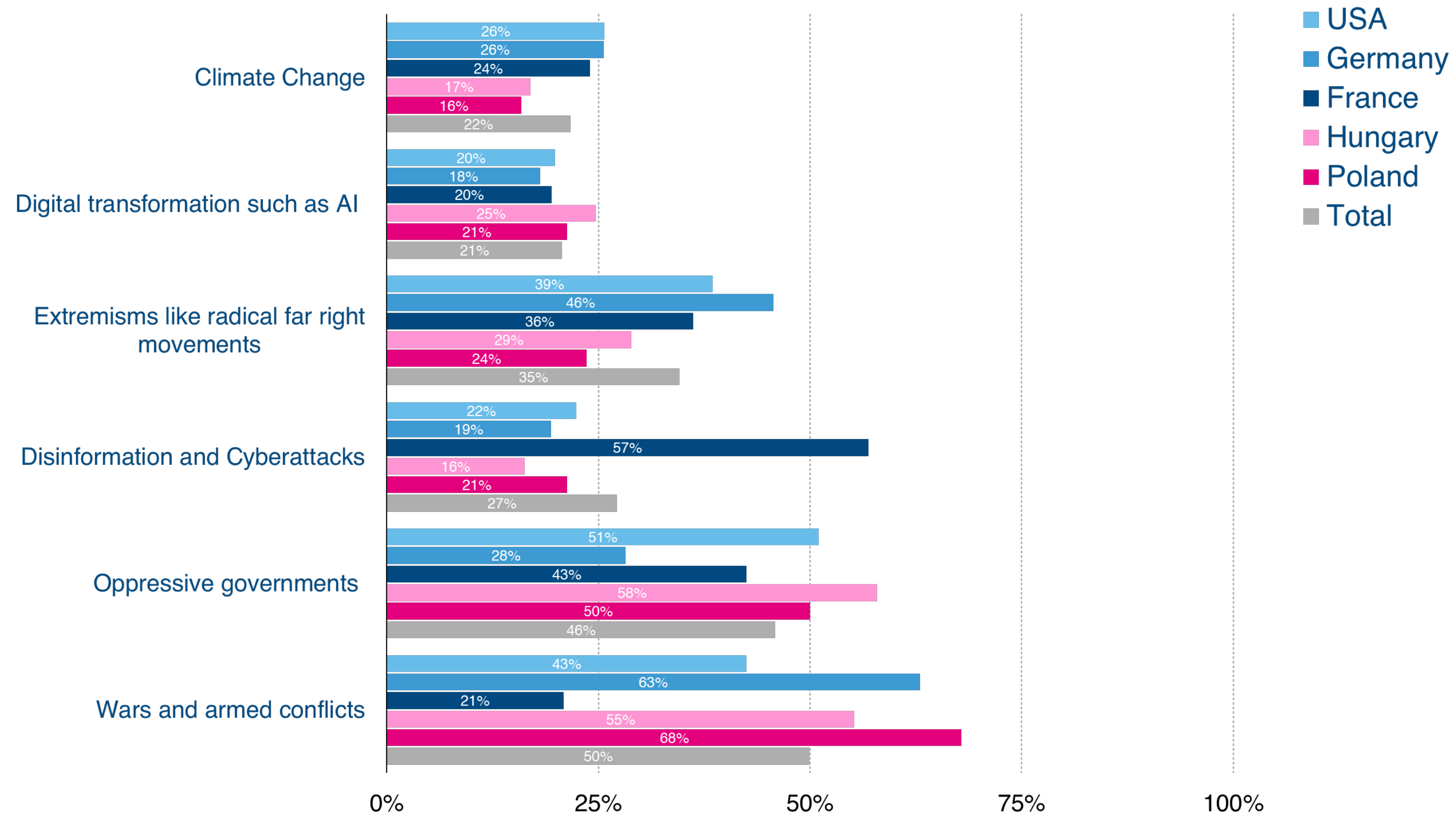

Freedom from any kind of discrimination.



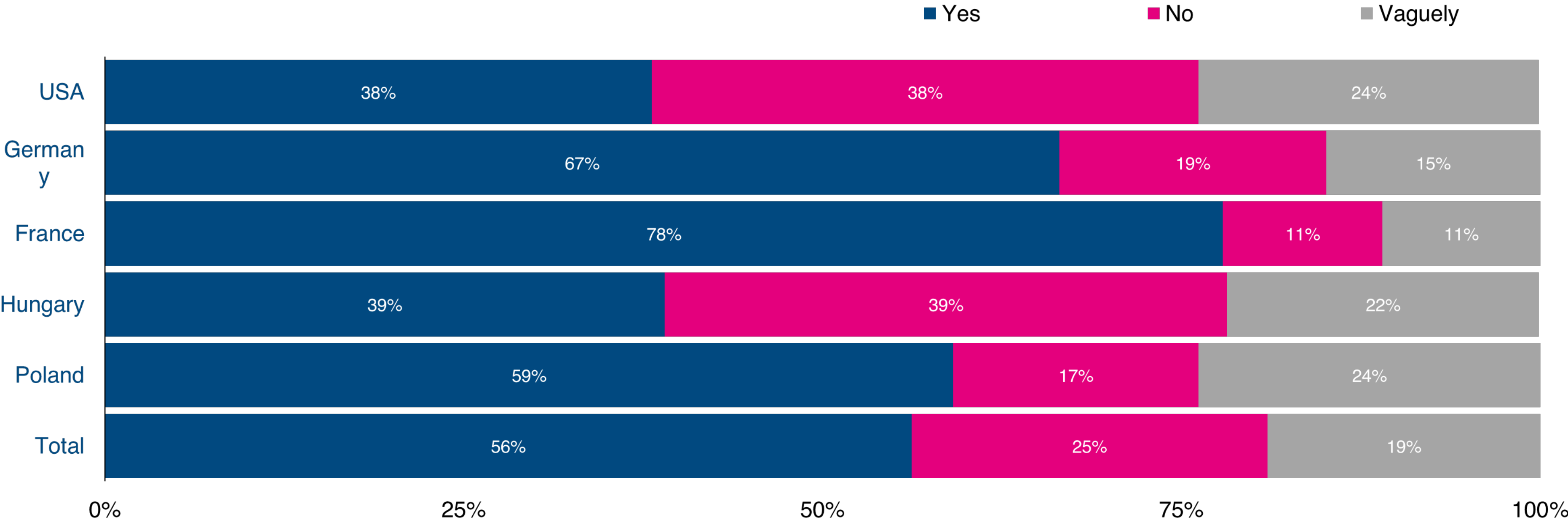
