







Do you think the majority of people in Russia live rather by the law or rather by informal rules, personal agreements?


Do you personally live rather by the law or rather by informal rules, personal agreements?










What is your opinion, should the state first of all guarantee rights and freedoms of citizens or should it first of all prevent law infringements and provide security?








What is your opinion, should or should not the state control prices of basic food products (e.g., bread, milk, meat, etc.)?









What is your opinion about the case that the wife earns more than the husband — positive, negative or indifferent?










Do you think that the mass media should always be controlled by the government, should be controlled only in special cases, e.g. for security reasons, or should be absolutely free?



If your opinion is not concurrent with the opinion of the majority, you are normally afraid or not afraid to express it?











Do you believe that it is important or not for the majority of Russians that there should be democracy in Russia, or they don't care?








