1) Background

The Friedrich Naumann Foundation for Freedom in Myanmar (FNF Myanmar) is looking to enhance research practice and to build quantitative analytical capacity among the staff of Yangon School of Political Science (YSPS). FNF Myanmar and YSPS will enroll YSPS surveyors and quantitative analysts to train them in quantitative research methodology and support them in their research and sampling designs.
